RE: Longhorn Mitigation Plan (LMP) Description Modification, Surge Analysis Review and Proposed Mitigation Measures Changes

Dear Mr. Materna:

PHMSA Office of Pipeline Safety (OPS) Central Region has received your letter dated December 2, 2022, regarding proposed modifications and enhancements in the capacity of the Longhorn Pipeline (Longhorn) refined products system from Crane, Texas to El Paso, Texas. Per Item 39 of the Longhorn Mitigation Plan (LMP) regarding commitments and consistent with prior modifications to throughput capacity on the system, Magellan Midstream Partners, L.P. (Magellan) proposes to modify the LMP System Description to show a new approved flowrate on the subject pipeline referenced above. Also, per Commitment Item 31 Magellan requests a review of the hydraulic surge analysis and approval of proposed mitigation measures.

Based on our review of the LMP System Description, hydraulic surge pressure analysis and the proposed mitigation measures provided by Magellan, the proposed modifications and enhancements are acceptable to OPS Central Region. Furthermore, OPS Central Region concurs with modifying the Longhorn Mitigation Plan Commitment description of the Crane, Texas to El Paso, Texas refined products system capacities.
